As you may or may not be aware the rounds that were scheduled to take place at Predannick on 20th June and 5th September have now been cancelled, as the events would run at a loss and in these difficult times it was a risk that the organisers were not prepared to take. Therefore this years Championship will now be contested over 12 rounds and therefore the best eight rounds will count.

After four rounds of the 2009 Championship, Andrew White is holding a slim lead over Dave Gardner, with John Forsyth and Rodney Thorne not far behind, but obviously there is still a long way to go.

PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE SCORING SYSTEM:

As I mentioned in my previous newsletter I have had a number of queries raised over the issue of points scoring within the Speed Championship, and people changing classes to a class with a "soft bogey time" which can easily be broken. Also with a wet event times will be slower than that of a dry event.

The following is how I feel that the point scoring system should be changed, and I welcome all of your feedback, obviously if I do not receive any feedback I will assume that all registered contenders are happy with the proposed changes and they will be submitted to the AGM for adoption by the membership.

Fastest Registered Competitor in Class: 25 points
if there is only one registered competitor in a class then 24 points will be awarded.

Second Fastest Registered Competitor in Class: 24 points

The remaining contenders will have 0.1 point deducted from the figure of 24, for each 0.1 of a second their time exceeds that of the second fastest registered competitor in class to a minimum of 1

Championship point. This will acknowledge those competitors that start an event but are not competitive but hopefully this will encourage them to still enter events.
