## ***PPs Pitstop.....***

Firstly, I would like to start off with an up date for those of you who are of a Hillclimb or Sprint persuasion of the changes that will come in to play in 2010.

- a. AGE: Cars built before 31.12.61 (1960 for racing and sports racing cars) will not have to comply with the category rules shown in the Blue Book. We will have to determine over the next year how the rules are put together for the older vehicles in our ASWMC Championship.
- b. TYRES: This is the issue that has concerned all of those in the road going classes. Unfortunately, I have not totally succeeded in getting my own way but in essence the second sentence of I.79 will be changed to say List 1A and List 1B. This therefore should suit most of your club members as competitors. Additionally if the competitor's vehicle was built before 31.12.76 your tyres need not come from either of these lists.

I can happily report that both of these changes have been approved by the MSA Hillclimb and Sprint sub-committee, Speed Events Committee . I will happily advise the ASWMC membership via Darren's Championship Newsletter. However, should any of these changes present any of the members or competitors with a problem then I would like to hear from them as soon as possible.

Elsewhere in the Newsletter you will see some significant changes to the Autotest Championship. The class structure has changed (and this is significant since the scores are based on the Class results). There have been two new classes for the "everyday" car. It is the intention that the nature of the tests that these vehicles will have to perform will be more straightforward and less manoeuvring in confined spaces. The aim of this is to encourage more competitors to join the Championship and it not be just confined to specialist Autotest cars.

The AGM also saw the introduction of the 2009 Endurance Rally Championship. Many of the association member clubs have organised these events or plan to organise them in the forthcoming year so it was decided that a Championship be introduced and we will gauge the response over the forth coming year.

The final change that came from the AGM was that a from 2009 the registration for Autotest and Car Trials (PCT) championships will be free and this will hopefully persuade more competitors into the sport and championship.

## **ENDURANCE RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP INTRODUCED 2009**

### REGULATIONS

1. The championship shall consist of a MAXIMUM of 8 events
2. The championship shall be class based.
3. Points will be awarded to registered contender. only, according to the following table.

Performance in EVENT CLASS, ignoring any event awards.

Championship contender	1	2	3	4	5	6
Points scored	18	15	13	12	11	10 to 15th place

PLUS

Relative ASWMC CLASS position of

Championship contender	1	2	3	4	5	6

Points will be awarded to both Driver and Co-Driver.

4. It is not necessary for a Driver and Co Driver to remain as a team throughout the duration of the championship.
5. In the event of a tie in the championship placing the championship will be awarded to the competitor gaining the greater number of maximum scores. If a tie still results the process shall be continued down the scoring table until it is resolved.
6. All events in the championship, and any other Endurance rallies which request it, will be observed and marked by Association appointed observers. The results of this marking may be used to form the basis of the succeeding year's championship.

### ***NEWS FROM THE MSA RALLIES COMMITTEE:***

The news to come from the most recent meeting is quite interesting as the following decisions have been made: There will not be an increase in the average speeds allowed on Special Stages on loose surfaces, this will remain at 65mph, as the MSA Insurers were not prepared to allow an increase.

It is also proposed to make the licensing of Special Stage Rally Clerks of the Course compulsory from the following dates:

Closed Public Roads	01/01/2010
Multi Venue	01/01/2011
Single Venue (Multi Use)	01/01/2012

Finally it is proposed to make 1986 FIA Standard Overalls unacceptable for Stage Rallies after 31/12/2009, and BS6658 Type A Helmets have been given a one years reprieve and are now valid until 31/12/2009.

## ***WEST'S WANDERINGS.....***

I have to start this month with a bit of a moan..... We have received a number of complaints from our Championship Sponsors that the event regulations are not publicising them, in some cases the name of the Championship is not shown at all or in some cases the incorrect sponsor, this has resulted in one case of the loss of the sponsor.

We would ask you to remember that without these sponsors the Championships would not be able to run successfully year after year, and to ensure that your regulations are as per Paragraphs 10 & 14 (on pages 7&8 of the 2008 yearbook). Championship Co-ordinators will now be clamping down on this and strictly enforcing Paragraph 11(a) which states that a set of draft regulations must be sent to the respective co-ordinator before address labels are issued. If the Sponsorship details are not correct, then the labels will not be issued, until the necessary changes have been made. If as a club, you continue to disregard these regulations then Championship Status for your events will be reviewed.

We would also ask that you also comply with Regulation 12 which deals with results and ask that you ensure that a copy of the results are forwarded to the Championship Co-ordinator within seven days of the event.

Moans over..... One of our sponsors, Richard Egger Insurance, has invited the ASWMC to man their stand at the Autosport Show in January at the NEC to promote the Association and our Championships.

If any Clubs are interested in assisting on the stand then can you please let Nic Ayre know as soon as possible, his contact details can be found on the front page of this newsletter.

You will recall that there was a petition to Gordon Brown, requesting that new residents in an area could not complain about noise from a long standing venue such as a race circuit, church or children's playground. The petition has been rejected outright and the reasons can be viewed on the following website:

Once again our government has avoided an issue that affects us all.

Finally there were a couple of changes on the executive at the AGM, as you will all recall Alison Ayre has stepped down as Registrations Secretary and Jannine Loveys will be filling her shoes from the start of the 2009 Championship year. On behalf of the Executive and the ASWMC we would like to thank Alison for all of her hard work over the years.

A new position of Cornwall Liaison Officer has been temporarily held by Pam Hartill after her co-option to the executive. It was agreed that she was elected to that position on a permanent basis and we would like to welcome Pam to the executive.

## **AUTOTEST RULE CHANGES**

### **2. Classes**

Class A: Road Going Saloon Cars.

Class B: Road Going Sports Cars, (excluding kit cars and all seven type derivatives).

Class C: Autotest Saloons up to 11ft overall length.

Class D: Autotest Saloons over 11ft overall length.

Class E: Sports and Kit Cars (including cabriolets running with hood down).

Class F: Specials.

**Note:** Classes may vary on events, where this occurs the results will be re-classified into the above class structure for allocation of points.

**Definitions: Class A & B Cars.** Must be taxed and MOT'd. It is intended for cars normally used on the road, and is not for full lightweight Autotest cars. Any car not in the spirit of the regulations will run in the appropriate Autotest Class.

### **3. Scoring.**

10 for 1<sup>st</sup> in Class, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for 8<sup>th</sup> or lower + 1 point for starting and 1 point for finishing.

If there is only one starter in a class, then 9 points will be awarded.

## **OPEN NAVIGATIONAL RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP**

Maximum number of events raised from 10 to 12 (detailed in 2 places)

4) Page 12 Additional Para 10 as follows:

A maximum of 2 Senior Officials on events may claim 12 championship points each for organising an event in the Championship calendar. This claim can only be made once in a Championship year. These Officials must be named in the event regulations. 5) Page 16 Para 1

## **HISTORIC RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP**

Maximum number of events increased from 8 to 12.

The following is also deleted: "of which a maximum of 2 events may be Sealed Surface Stage Rallies".

## **SEALED SURFACE RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP:**

RULE 1 has been amended to read 14 Events and NOT 12

## **HISTORIC STAGE CHAMPIONSHIP**

RULE 1 has been amended to read 14 not 10 events.

To make this work we need the co-operation of event organisers to think more carefully about test design and make enough room for the larger cars, the tests in some cases need to be simplified to help encourage new competitors to come and have a go. A similar class structure is also being used in the ACSMC Southern Championship, so at the end of the year we will see how the new initiative works. There will be a set of recommendations coming out in the very near future, these will be sent out to the organising clubs and will be available for download from the website.

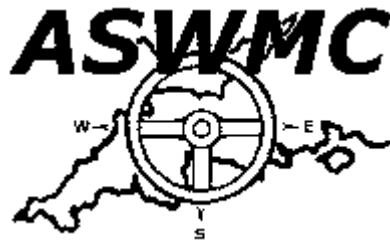
