A FEW WORDS FROM THE CHAIRMAN

I want to begin by thanking you all, both Organisers and Championship Contenders alike, for the continued support you have given, despite these being difficult times, to all our ASWMC Championships. As a Regional Association we have amongst the widest range of Championships of all Regions in the UK. Given where we are that does avoid the need for many of you to travel quite so far to enjoy your Motor Sport.

Motor Sport has successfully fought off the Government's review, for the second time in a decade, of the "14/28 day rule" which enables most motor sport to take place at a venue, without having to seek formal planning permission. Had the Government had its way and removed that rule, all Clubs would have had to seek formal planning permission for each venue that it used for all disciplines. The time constraints don't bear thinking about and the vast majority of Motor Sport would have been devastated had they been successful.

In certain parts of the country events have had to be cancelled because entries have been insufficient (in some parts championships have been lost because so many events were lost). It is now becoming far too widespread that Competitors are submitting their entries very late. Might I suggest that Organisers help themselves by undertaking not to bank entry fees before a certain date, closer to the event, and Competitors play their part (and avoid cancellation of events when not enough entries have been received by "decision time") by submitting their entries that little bit earlier.

Motor Sport has lost quite a few of its venues in the last year or two. Indeed we have, in the South West, our own experience of losing venues in recent years. The ASWMC has appointed a sub Committee to work toward uncovering additional venues. This will be a lengthy process, and possibly has no natural end, but your Regional Association will play its part in trying to help Organising Clubs obtain a home for its Motor Sport. Despite that, I have to say, we are in the South West very fortunate in the range and number of venues available to us. We have far, far more than just about anywhere else in the UK. Nonetheless more are always needed and hence the work we have undertaken.

Motor Sports Council of MSA considered a new rule for next year, last month, which would enable clubs to organise one "Taster Event" each year in each of the disciplines in D.4.5 which would enable members of the public to take part, without first becoming club members, in a bid to encourage them to join. I haven't yet seen the Minutes of that meeting as I write this but clubs might like to give it some thought in Committees?

Finally can I give you from your Regional Association the warmest and happiest New Year greetings and hope that your 2012 is successful.

2011 Bridge Tyres and Wheels ASWMC Hill Climb and Sprint Championships

The 2011 Bridge Tyres & Wheels ASWMC Hill Climb championship was reasonably well contested with 142 registered contenders 92 of whom scored points. The top end of the championship was well fought between Martyn Pike and Mike Lee. Mike unfortunately had to have an engine rebuilt during August after a Cam chain broke on his potent Hayabusa engine, but barring mistakes Martyn had the upper hand by a very small margin at around this time. The next few places were also well contested with Philip Pearn just getting the edge on Melvyn James. Melvyn could have been competing with Martyn and Mike if only the promised B1 contestants actually turned up, this meant that Melvyn had very few class competitors to score against. But on the whole the championship was well fought out all the way and the number of competitors that had dropped scores was amazing.

The 2011 Bridge Tyres & Wheels Sprint Championship started off as a 3 horse race between Ian Parr, Luke Wilcox and Ian Beacham at around two thirds of the way through the rounds Ian Parr dropped out of the race for the title and Ian Beacham stepped up and took over by this time Ian Beacham had a slightly better score rate, and he was the only competitor to have a drop score in this championship. Well done to Luke Wilcox and Ross Whittock for 2nd and 3rd respectively in the championship. The Sprint championship had 89 registered contenders 62 of whom scored points.

Southern Counties Autocross Championship

Considering the economy etc., this Championship was very well supported with 44 registered contenders of whom 41 took part in at least one event. In the end there were 14 qualifying rounds organised by six motor clubs commencing in mid April and finishing in mid September. At least 8 of the rounds were run as two-day events which seem to be favoured by competitors as a way of maximizing the number of events that they can compete in but with less travelling.

The class structure seemed to work out well and at the end of the championship, the first five competitors were from 5 different classes. There was a problem regarding Class F (Juniors) and the interpretation of the MSA regulations towards the end of the championship but it did not affect the overall results.

Congratulations to Andy Hoare from Ferndown who was very consistent in Class B throughout the year with his faithful Mini and will be rewarded with the top award. Congratulations also to Richard Davies from Haverfordwest who was second overall and top A2 Class competitor in his Nissan Almera, Richard was crowned British Champion at the final round of that Championship at the end of August.

Looking ahead to 2012

There are a few changes to the regulations for 2012, which were approved by Council at the AGM in October. The split of Class E was introduced by one or two clubs this year and seemed to be well received and so it is my intention to run Class E1 for outright specials whether 2wd or 4wd and Class E2 for 4wd Production based saloons.

My other change is the scoring system as applied to low numbers in class. In my opinion the 1 point reduction for a competitor who is the sole entry in that class, is insufficient. It has therefore been approved that where there is a Class of **ONE**, that competitor will be awarded a score of 23 points. We will also be reverting to the basic Association Championship Rule 18 with regard to Ties

The calendar for 2012 is now complete. There will be a total of 16 rounds spread over nine weekends which is actually three weekends less than 2011. The top 8 best results will still determine the winner subject to 12 events or more taking place.
