SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- I. CAMEL VALE MOTOR CLUB will organise a Clubmans Permit Sporting Trial on Sunday 11th June 2017 at Poldew Farm, Lostwithiel, Cornwall. PL22 0HX MR200/093600......B3269 Bodmin to Lostwithiel
- 2. The meeting will be held under The General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations.
- 3. MSA Permit has been applied for
- 4. The event is open to fully elected members of the organising club, BTRDA, Launceston & North Cornwall MC, 750 MC, SportingTrials.com, NPTCC. Registered members of the ASWMC Reis Motorsport Insurance Sporting Trials Championship (Championship Permit 71/2017)
- 5a. All drivers must produce a valid Club Membership Card, and championship contenders a valid MSA Competition Licence
- 6. The programme of the meeting will be:

Scrutineering starts at 10:30am
Any competitor not signed on by 11:00am may be excluded.
First car starts 11:00am

- 7. Public roads will not be used to link sections. Details of the sections will be issued at signing on. The entry will be split into groups starting at different hills. There will be a 10 minute break between rounds 1 & 2 to give the chance to alter sections. A lunch break will be taken between rounds 2 & 3.
- 8. The event will consist of three classes as follows:
 - 1. Red category drivers as per the BTRDA listings
 - 2. Blue.category drivers as per the BTRDA listings
 - 3. Green category drivers as per the BTRDA listings, Clubman and all others
- 9. All vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations. All vehicles must have effective silencing. Any vehicle deemed to be too noisy by the scrutineer, will not be allowed to start.

10. Awards will be presented as follows:

Overall Award - Calvin Kneebone Trophy

Class Win - subject to 3 starters in class except overall winner

Second in Class - subject to 5 starters in class

Third in Class - subject to 9 starters in class

Points will be earned for the Camel Vale Car Trophy and Brewer Cup, to be awarded annually.
