[17] Protests

Protests must be logged in accordance with Section C.

[18] Other Requirements/Information

Marking and penalties will be as printed in section T.6 MSA Regs 2018, with the modification of T6.3.2 to incorporate the 3 second ruling, where a competitor can sit with spinning wheels and no forward motion for a count of 3 seconds only. After that time forward motion is deemed to have ceased and the marshal will award points for that position.

An engine stall is considered an immediate stop and no time allowance will be made for restarting, with the exception of a stall on a downhill section where the car keeps moving and the competitor is able to restart the engine, then there is no penalty.

Cars may be double driven.

Competitors may only use the following tyres Vredestein T-Trac2, Nankang CX668, Maxxis MA510N as appropriate to the relevant championship regulations.

Please note that if you are competing in the BTRDA/MSA Championships then you MUST only use the Nankang CX668, Maxxis MA510N or Vredestein T-Trac2 tyres. Compliance with this will be checked at signing on and subsequently during the day. Any BTRDA/MSA competitor found to be not using the approved tyres will be allowed to complete the event but their scores will NOT count towards the BTRDA/MSA championship. If any competitors tyres are found to have scrubbed sidewalls then that competitor will be immediately excluded from the event and reported to the MSA.

Tyre pressures will be advised at the start and may be checked during the event with the clubs pressure gauge. The CoC reserves the right to amend tyre pressures by up to 5psi during the trial.

A brake and differential test will be performed on each competing car before the start of the event.

Any driver allowing an unauthorised person (i.e. one who has not signed on the official indemnity form for the event) to drive their car will be disqualified from the event immediately.

A Google maps link will be included with the finals as there is no official post code for the site.

Please Note; Access to the site from the South is extremely difficult for any vehicle with a trailer as there is a 180 degree hairpin to turn into the road leading to the site, which is so tight that vans etc. have to shunt to get around it, so please approach the site from the North
