Appendix 1 REVISIONS OF ASSOCIATION RULES AND REGULATIONS AGREED AT THE AGM.

The following changes will be included into the 2019 ASWMC Yearbook Championship Rules. All references relate to the 2018 Yearbook texts.and paragraph numbers

#### 1) HILLCLIMB AND SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIPS, Proposed by Roy Sims

a) Page 22 Note 2 to be deleted. Therefore current note 3 will become Note 2, Note 4 becomes 3, and Note 5 becomes 4

### 2) AUTOCROSS CHAMPIONSHIP Proposed by Colin Anderson

- a) Page 24 Note3.i), to be deleted.
- b) Page 24 Note3.ii) to be deleted
- c) Page 25 Note3 iv) Amended to read:- Competitors in Classes G1 and G2 may request to practice and compete on timed runs alongside cars within these classes, or singularly.
- d) Page 25 Note 4 Delete second sentence referring to Classes A1 and A2
- e) Page 25 Note 5 Delete the word "Round", replace with "Event"
- f) Also add: "A maximum score shall be 30 points for any Competitor or Competitors acting as Clerk of the Course on a Championship Round"...
- g) Page 24 Note 6 Amend points on the Chart for 2 Starters in Class to 14, and 13 points for the second. Also for 1 Starter in Class, to 13 points.

## 3) CAR TRIALS CHAMPIONSHIP Proposed by Mark Hoppe

These new rules completely supercede the existing rules in the 2018 Yearbook

- Classes: Will be defined in the Supplementary regulations for each event.
- Championship New addition, (Replaces Regulation 18 in the 2018 ASWMC Championship Rules)

- a) The Championship will be awarded to the driver who scores the highest amount of points from any 3 championship rounds plus the score from the nominated season finale
- b) Ties at the end of the championship will be resolved in favour of the driver finishing highest on Index of Performance (IOP) at the finale.
- c) IOP will be calculated as per the prevailing MSA blue book definition
- d) The season finale will be run in line with the suggested Class structure from the MSA Yearbook for Car trials (eg 3 Classes)"
  - 3. Scoring Contenders will score points as follows
  - I) Class Winner 10 points (assuming 3 or more starters). If less than 3 starters in the Class, the Winner will receive 9 points.
  - II) Runner Up (2<sup>nd</sup>) will score less 1 point, 3<sup>rd</sup> will score the second place score less 1 point etc, down the Class.
  - III) Points are awarded to 10<sup>th</sup> place in Class. All starters will score a minimum of 1 point for each Event started.
  - IV) Points at the nominated season Finale will be double that described in i),ii), and iii) above"
    - 4. Awards to be presented as per Championship Rule 19

#### 4) ASSOCIATION CHAMPIONSHIP RULES Proposed by Paul Parker

- a) Page 9 Para. 2 1<sup>st</sup> sentence delete Autotest. Add (after the word Championships) no Clubmans licence may be required in these disciplines if the event is run to a Clubmans status permit.
- b) Page 9 Para 8a) Delete 3<sup>rd</sup> sentence (for Autosolo, Autotest, and Trials, Clubmans status events are permitted). Add 3<sup>rd</sup> sentence for Autosolos, and Trials, Clubmans status events are permitted.
