

- The 750 Motor Club will organise a dual permit (Clubsport and National B) Sporting Car Trial on <u>Sunday</u> 17th February 2019 at Bidfield Farm, Camp, Stroud, Glos. GL6 7ET (OS Ref 163/908105).
- 2. Held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations.
- 3. MSA Permit Numbers TBC and TBC have been issued.
- 4. The Clubsport event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club, Sporting Trials.com, Camel Vale Motor Club, Ross & District Motor Club, and Bristol Motor Club. All drivers must produce a valid Club Membership Card.

The National B event is open to all members of the organising club, of the BTRDA or the ASWMC. All drivers must produce a Competition Licence of the correct Grade

- The Trial is a round of '750 MC Sporting Trial Championship' (both events) and the '2019 REIS Motorsport Insurance ASWMC Sporting trials championship' – Championship Registration Number TBA (National B event only).
- 6. Scrutineering starts at **9.30 am**. Any competitor not signed on by 10.00 am may be excluded. First car starts at **10.30 am**.
- 7. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 6 sections on private land. Details of the sections will be issued at signing on. The entry may be split into groups starting at different hills.
- 8. The event will consist of classes as follows: (See note 17)
 - 'A' Expert (Live / Independent)
 - 'B' Semi Expert (Live / Independent)
 - 'C' Novice
 - 'D' Post Historic

All vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations, Sections E12 and M5 (except M5.8.1 and M5.8.2) and with the National Trials Car Formula.

- 9. Awards will be presented as follows : (See note 17)
 - i Best Overall 750 MC Member
 - ii Best Overall Non 750 MC
 - iii 1st in Class A or 1st in Class B, (dependant on ii above)
 - iv 2nd in Class A or 2nd in Claas B

(Subject to at least 3 entries per class)

- V Best Novice (Subject to at least 3 Novice entries)
- Vi Best Post Historic
- 10. The Entry List opens on receipt of these regulations and closes finally on **Monday 11th February 2019 (18:00 hrs)**. The entry fee is £35. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

- 14. Starting numbers will be decided by ballot. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be supplied by the organisers.
- 15. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the MSA Regulations. All other Regulations of the MSA apply as written.
- 16. For the purposes of classes and awards the Clubsport and National B events will be combined.
- 17. ASWMC Championship points will be awarded on the basis of the BTRDA Red/Blue/Green class structure.
- 18. Sections will be laid out using bamboo poles with those on the right painted red
