SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. CAMEL VALE MOTOR CLUB will organise a dual National B / Clubmans Permit Sporting Trial on Sunday 12th May 2019 at Penvose Farm, St Tudy, Cornwall. PL30 3NP MR: 200/058779.
2. The meeting will be held under The General Regulations of Motorsport UK. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these supplementary regulations
3. MSA Permits (National B - tba) (Clubmans - tba)
ASWMC Sporting Trials Championship Permit 38/2019
4. The event is a round of the 2019 BTRDA Sporting Trials Championship & the ASWMC 2019 Sporting Trials Championship. The event is open to fully elected members of the organising club and registered contenders in the qualifying Championships.
- 5a. All drivers must produce a valid Club Membership Card, Competition Licence & Championship registration card, if applicable. Non-championship competitors, under the Clubmans permit, are not required to produce a competition licence.
- 5b. All passengers, as per Motorsport UK Regulations, must be members of a Motorsport UK affiliated club for all National B events. A valid club membership card must be produced at signing on. Camel Vale Motor Club can offer annual passenger membership for £2, available at signing on.
6. The programme of the meeting will be:

Scrutineering starts at 10:00am
Any competitor not signed on by 11:00am may be excluded.
First car starts 11:15am
7. There will be at least 24 sections on private land. Details of the sections will be issued at signing on. The entry will be split into groups starting at different hills. There will be a 10 minute break between rounds 1 & 2 to give the chance to alter sections. A lunch break will be taken between rounds 2 & 3.

8. The event will consist of five classes as follows:
 1. Expert Driver Independent Suspension as per the BTRDA listings.
 2. Expert Driver Live Axle as per the BTRDA listings
 3. Intermediate Driver Independent Suspension as per the BTRDA listings
 4. Expert driver Live Axle as per the BTRDA listings
 5. Rookie driver as per the BTRDA listings, Clubman and all others
9. All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations. All vehicles must have effective silencing. Any vehicle deemed to be too noisy by the scrutineer, will not be allowed to start.
10. All Championship contending vehicles must comply with BTRDA / Motorsport UK tyre regulations. Vehicles entered under the Clubmans permit (Non Championship) must use permitted tyres as per 2019 MSA listings.
11. Awards will be presented as follows:

Overall winner - The Four Turnings Trophy (to be held for 11 months) & Replica

First in Class Award (Subject to 3 starters in Class - *except overall winner*)

Second in Class Award (Subject to 5 starters in Class)

Third in Class Award (Subject to 9 starters in Class)

Points will be earned by Camel Vale members for the Camel Vale Car Trophy. Brewer Cup, Under 21 Trophy and Brian Rabey Trophy to be awarded annually.

12. The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations and closes finally on Wednesday 8 May 2019. The entry fee is £30.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee.

14. The maximum number of entries for the meeting, including reserves, is 40. The minimum is 8. The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate the Classes as necessary. Entries will be selected by random draw. Entry fee will be refunded if notice of withdrawal is given in writing by the closing date. A refund may be made after such time as applicable.

16. Preliminary results will be available following the event.

Provisional results will be published in accordance with D26.1.3

17. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with 2019 Motorsport UK Year Book.

18. Competitors will be identified by numbers provided by the organisers.

19. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations.
